These Westwood One products and services are fed on satellite SES-11 at 105 degrees West Longitude, on Transponder 17, Vertical polarization.

XDS Receiver Frequency: 01121000 kHz (1121.0 MHz)  
9259574 sps (symbols per second)  
Rate 3/4 FEC (Forward Error Correction)

To receive these programs, your station will need:

1. Satellite Dish: We recommend a solid dish of at least 3.8 meters in diameter.

2. LNB: You must use a C-band Phase-Locked Loop (PLL) LNB. Local oscillator stability +/- 25 kHz or tighter. Noise temperature 45°K or less. Gain 55 to 70 dB.
